Plan ahead before going to see any health care provider and prepare for your office visit. Most appointments are scheduled for only 10 to 15 minutes. By following the guidelines below you will save time for both you and your doctor and have a better visit overall.

- Call in advance to make an appointment. Ask about wait time so you can plan ahead.
- Arrive a few minutes early to take care of any paperwork before your scheduled appointment.
- Write down your medical history and bring it with you.
- Make a list of what is bothering you, include all symptoms.
- Bring all of your medications and supplements with you.
- Make sure your doctor's office knows of any allergies you have.
- Bring a pad and pen. Write down the diagnosis, treatment, follow-up plan, and what you can do at home to help yourself.
- Write down the three most important questions that you want to have answered. There may not be time to ask a long list of questions.
- Ask a friend or family member to come with you so there is someone else present to listen or to take notes for you.
- If your doctor prescribes medication, ask for samples. Don't be afraid to tell your doctor you are on a budget or can't afford ALL of the medication prescribed for you.
- Make your next appointment before you leave the office and write it down so you don't forget.
- If you can not keep your appointment, call the office to let them know.
